## Herman Wald

### Exhibition

AN EXHIBITION of various works of the late Herman Wald, is to be presented at the Morris Gallery from December 6 to January 12.

Mr Wald is remembered for his many artistic creations that are to be found in many parts of the Republic and especially, for his monument to the six million martyrs who died in the Nazi holocaust, to be seen at the West Park Cemetery, the monument "Kria" in the grounds of the Jewish Aged Home, and the arch of leaping buck on the Oppenheimer fountain in Johannesburg.

The exhibition is to be opened by Professor Gideon Jacobs, director of the Graduate School of Business Administration at the University of the Witwatersrand, on Thursday December 6 at 5.30 p.m.

A number of Herman Wald's sculptures will be exhibited as well as photographs of erected works and monuments.
