Sir,—Reading the interesting article in your "Serious and Otherwise" column on Bernard Sopher's "Monument to Mother" (duly illustrated), I was forcibly reminded that the first monument to the Jewish refugee mother was created some years ago in Johannesburg. The work, of infinite strength and excellent composition, was sculptured by the well-known, but unfortunately not sufficiently appreciated Johannesburg sculptor, Herman Wald. It was originally exhibited in 1937, at the Jewish Refugees Aid Exhibition, held at Lidchi's Galleries, and is at present on loan to the S.A. Jewish Board of Education.
