GIANT CARVING: Mr. Herman Wald, the Johannesburg sculptor, has executed this wood carving for the grill over the Ark for the new synagogue soon to be opened in Springs. The carving is dominated by the "Menorah" —the seven-branched candlestick—and, running parallel to it, is the ritual symbol of the palm branch of the tabernacle. The Hebrew inscription of the Ten Commandments is flanked by the Lion of Judah. The preview of the synagogue takes place to-morrow.
