

# Symbol of diamond mining ✓

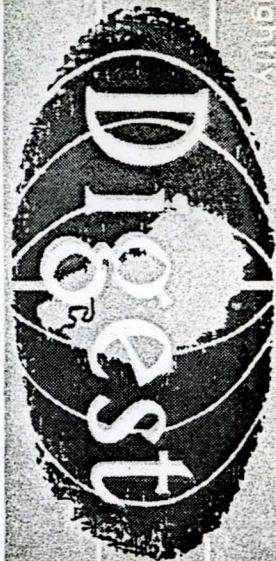
