

## IN HONOUR OF DIGGERS

A commemorative garden has been laid out in the heart of the new community centre in Kimberley, in honour of Sir Ernest Oppenheimer and in appreciation of the part he played in the development of both the diamond industry and the city of Kimberley. The focal point of the garden is a monument erected in honour of the diamond diggers. This is at the same time a fountain. A large round sieve is held on high by five life-size muscular bronze figures. The monument was designed by Herman Walil of Johannesburg, and cast in Italy.
